## *IRKS SOARING FESTIVAL (FSS CONTEST #1)*

February 20 (Saturday) and 21 (Sunday), 2010

**Space Coast Aeromodeling Park**, 2250 Adamson Road, Cocoa, Florida 32926. The flying field is located within the Brevard County Waste Management Site and all entry is controlled at the gate.

Adamson Road begins 1.2 miles west of I-95 Exit 202 on SR 524 and runs north. The entrance to the flying site is 2.0 miles north of SR 524 on the west side of Adamson Road. Look for the IRKS tent at the entrance. Do not block the arriving heavy truck traffic at the entrance weigh scale.

**Tasks;** Thermal Duration with task times from 3 to 10 minutes with L-5 landing. Actual task times will be set at pilots' meeting each day depending upon weather. Goal is seven rounds each day.

**Registration:** Sailplane field will be open at 0830 for practice on Saturday. Registration at 0900 on Saturday with Pilots' Meeting at 0945. Sunday, registration opens at 0800 with pilots' meeting at 0845. Contest will begin 15 minutes after Pilots' Meeting each day. 2010 AMA cards must be shown.

**Classes;** Saturday, 444 (UNL) and 442 (2-Meter), Sunday, 444 (UNL) and 460 (RES)

**Awards;** Traditional FSS Awards, Expert and Sportsman, in UNL both days and for 2-Meter on Saturday. IRKS will give special, non-FSS, RES awards on Sunday; three places for Expert and two for Sportsman.

**Flight Order:** Open winch with retriever.

**FREQUENCY CONTROL WILL BE IN EFFECT AT ALL TIMES AND ALL NON-2.4 TRANSMITTERS MUST BE IMMEDIATELY IMPOUNDED UPON ARRIVAL.** Unrestricted power flying will be permitted until 0900 on Saturday and 0800 on Sunday at which time the entire field will be CLOSED to other than registered (contest) sailplanes. Entire site will open to power flying both days AFTER soaring contest is finished.

**Fees:** \$15 for each class entry each day. \$2 of this goes to FSS. Cash only, please!

**Lunch:** Catered by the famous *Slow and Low BBQ of Cocoa Beach*. Pilots wishing to buy delicious lunch and drinks may order from their large, inexpensive menu at registration time. Individual orders will then be phoned in for HOT delivery at lunch break each day. Individuals are asked to pay by cash only. No alcoholic beverages are allowed at any time on the IRKS field.

No overnight camping is allowed at the flying site

*Because of County regulations, normal admission to flying site is only for IRKS club members and their family. If you do not carry an IRKS membership card, arrangements will have been made for your entry as a guest or visiting competitor on Saturday and Sunday. This will be accomplished if you stop at the IRKS table at the entry gate to the flying site where you will be issued an IRKS Guest Pass for each day. Guests are asked to bring a copy of this advertisement to show at entry.*
